

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR EXHIBITORS**

### **PRAGA 2028 EXPO**

#### **Article I**

##### **Event Organizer**

#### **Article II**

##### **Applications and Site Allocation**

1. The application for participation is binding for the exhibitor. The Organizer shall decide on the acceptance, restriction, or refusal of the application without any obligation to explain the decision.
2. The certificate of final site allocation shall be provided by the Organizer at least two weeks before the exhibition, provided that the exhibitor has paid the rent in full by the due date specified in the invoice. The full payment of the rent is a strict condition for handing over the stand or table to the Exhibitor before the opening of the exhibition.
3. If the Exhibitor fails to pay the rent by the due date specified in the invoice, this delay shall be considered a material breach of contract, and the Organizer reserves the right to withdraw from the Contract.
4. The Exhibitor undertakes to comply with all obligations resulting from their participation, as well as the participation of co-exhibitors whom the Exhibitor has contracted to deliver exhibits. Any potential changes are subject to prior written approval by the Organizer.

#### **Article III**

##### **Rent and Exhibition Sites**

1. The rent for exhibition sites is always specified in the application form or in the Organizer's official letter.
2. The allocated exhibition site must not be transferred or sublet by the Exhibitor to any third party without the prior written approval of the Organizer.
3. The Exhibitor shall pay a cancellation fee of EUR 100 if their participation in the exhibition is cancelled before the exhibition space is allocated. After the allocation of the exhibition space, the Exhibitor shall immediately pay a cancellation fee equal to 100% of the total amount stated in the application form.

## **Article IV**

### **Terms of Payment**

The Exhibitor undertakes to pay the Organizer for all provided services and fulfillment by the due date specified on the invoice.

## **Article V**

### **Goods and Exhibits**

1. The Exhibitor is obliged to display the prices of the goods. The Exhibitor must properly secure all goods against theft.
2. The transport of goods to and from the venue must comply with the Organizer's instructions. The Exhibitor is obliged to arrange and pay for the transport of all installation materials and goods to the exhibition venue. Handling and storage fees will be charged for any goods and installation materials that are not removed by the final dismantling deadline.
3. The receipt of products and goods must be handled exclusively by the Exhibitor. If neither the Exhibitor nor their authorized representative is present, the goods will be unloaded at the allocated site entirely at the Exhibitor's own risk.

## **Article VI**

### **Exposition Construction, Installation, and Assembly**

1. The schedule for installation, dismantling, and operating hours is determined by the Organizer. Any exception to this schedule may be granted by the Organizer upon the Exhibitor's or their representative's request. The Exhibitor or their representative shall reimburse all additional costs arising from such an exception.
2. The official contractor for stand construction is Double Impact s.r.o. If the exposition is constructed by a contractor other than the official one, the Exhibitor remains fully responsible for their activities, particularly for compliance with installation and dismantling deadlines.
3. The Exhibitor is entitled to promote their products only within the boundaries of their own allocated stand or table.
4. All methods of presentation and exhibition at the allocated site or elsewhere within the venue must be approved in advance by the Organizer.

## **Article VII**

### **Insurance and Liability**

The Organizer shall not be held liable for the loss, destruction, or any damage to goods, equipment, stands, packages, and packaging materials belonging to the Exhibitor or their co-exhibitors, regardless of whether such damage occurred before, during or after the exhibition. The Exhibitor is obliged to arrange appropriate insurance coverage for these purposes.

## **Article VIII**

### **Final Provisions**

1. If the Organizer is unable to open the exhibition, ensure its operation for the entire duration, or provide access to the venue (or any part thereof) due to circumstances beyond their control ("force majeure"), the Organizer must immediately notify the Exhibitor. In such a case, all contractual obligations regarding the Exhibitor's participation shall expire. The Exhibitor shall not be entitled to any compensation for damages. The Organizer reserves the right to retain an appropriate portion of the payments already made by the Exhibitor to cover incurred costs.
2. The Exhibitor may file a claim or complaint regarding the works and services provided by the Organizer with the designated responsible employee. This must be done at least 48 hours before the official end of the exhibition; otherwise, the right to file a claim expires.
3. Unless specified otherwise, the Organizer reserves the right to exclude the Exhibitor from participation in the exhibition in the event of a breach of any of the above-listed provisions. In this case, the Exhibitor shall have no right to compensation for potential damages or to a refund of the paid rent.
